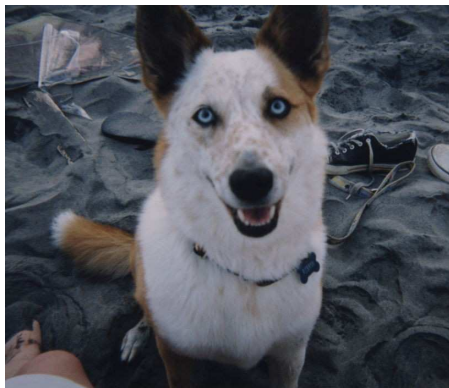


## Expectations of Laser Therapy Treatment

- Most chronic conditions will show a positive response in 3 to 4 treatments. You should expect at LEAST a 50% improvement in mobility and pain reductions.
- Some pets respond positively to just ONE treatment.
- The treated site feels better immediately or within 12 to 24 hours after treatment.
- Definite improvements should be seen by the SECOND week of treatments.
- Treatment effects are CUMULATIVE in nature.
- Some patients develop a habit of altering their movements to keep from feeling pain. If you do not see an immediate change, they may be pain free, but need some time to re-adjust their movements.
- Current users report over 90% of cases improve.

## What Is Laser Therapy?

We have acquired a therapeutic laser (low intensity laser therapy also known as cold laser ) which is a highly effective treatment for soft tissue injuries, pain, arthritis, and certain other conditions. This technique is called Low Intensity Laser Therapy (LILT). This rapidly growing technology represents a major advancement in the treatment of musculoskeletal disorders.

Designed to give your pet fast pain relief and improved healing times, the Companion Laser Therapy System is the most powerful laser therapy system available today.

Current medical recommendations are customized for your pet by our expert doctors. Some patients will require an initial aggressive course of treatments, while others may only require 1 or 2 treatments.

Treatments last an average of 2-5 minutes, with larger areas taking up to 10 minutes. After the first initial treatment, all follow up appointments may be scheduled with a technician rather than a doctor, which as a rule grants us the ability to offer you more flexibility of available appointment times.



## Initial Treatment Package



Laser therapy may be beneficial in providing:

- Analgesic effect for wounds, post surgical pain, infections, joint pain, and arthritis.
- Relief for ear infections (otitis externa) and ear hematomas.
- As an anti-inflammatory by increasing vasodilation and decreasing edema.
- Faster wound healing by improving vascular activity and increasing collagen production.
- Some cases of anti-microbial effects.
